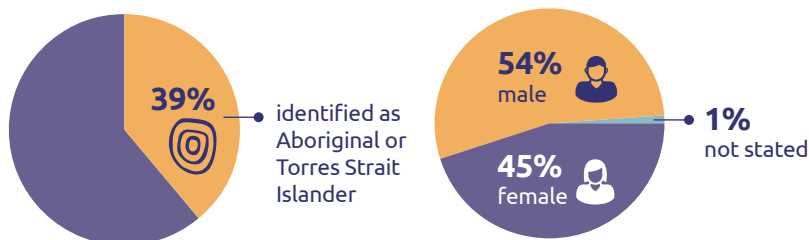


Skilling the Territory Investment Plan 2022-23

What we have achieved

2021 saw **15,083 VET students** supported by Government* funded training activities in the NT.

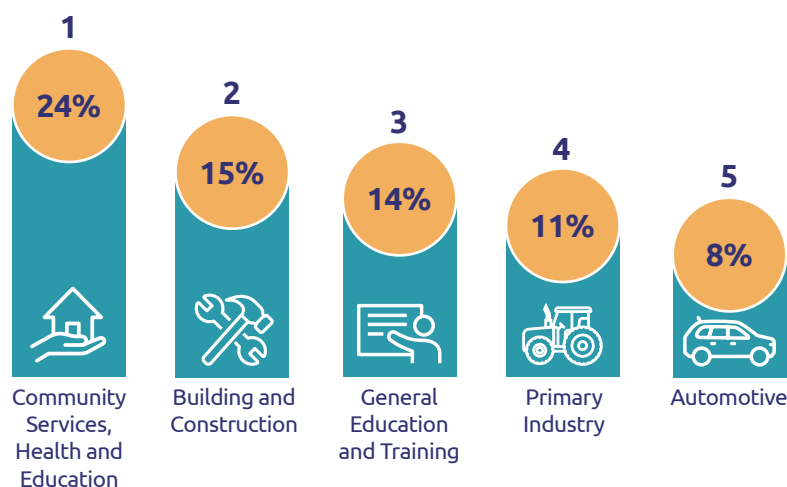


48% of unemployed people who undertook training gained employment

90.8% of those employed after training received a job-related benefit

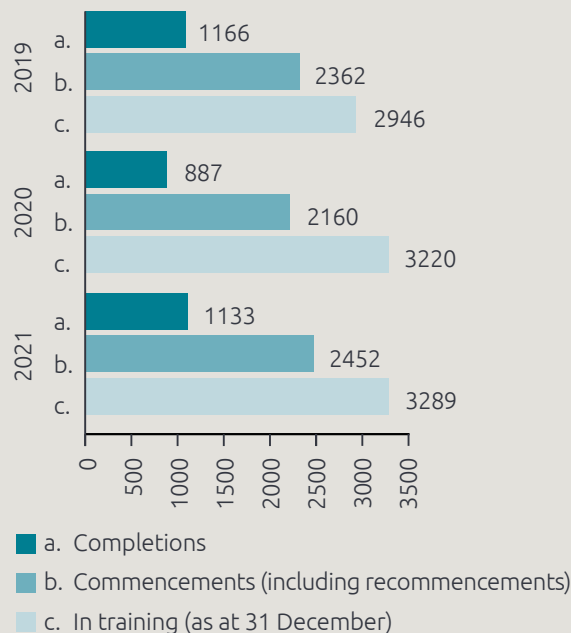
81.9% improved their employment status after training at Certificate I and II level (the highest in the country)

Top 5 industry groups by Government funding amount

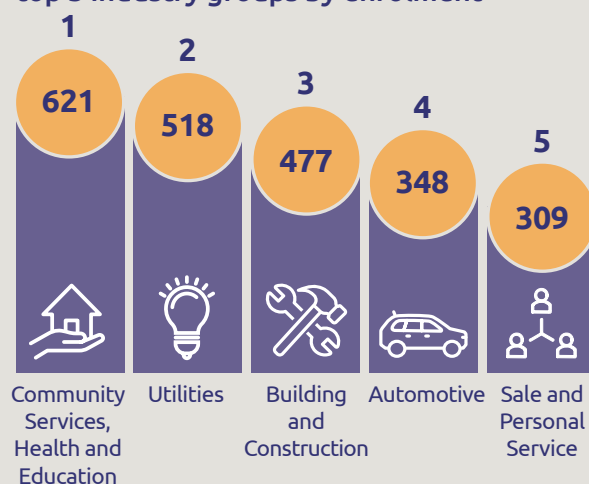

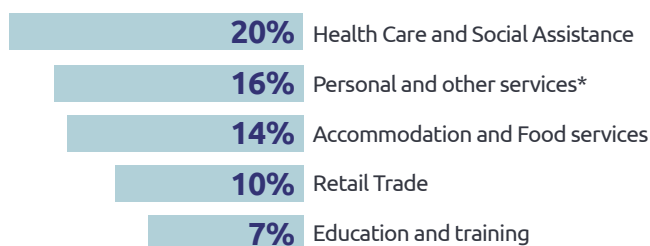


Apprenticeship and traineeship top 5 industry groups by enrolment

General Skilled Migration

1200 nominations issued in the 2021-22 program year achieving **100%** of the allocated quota.

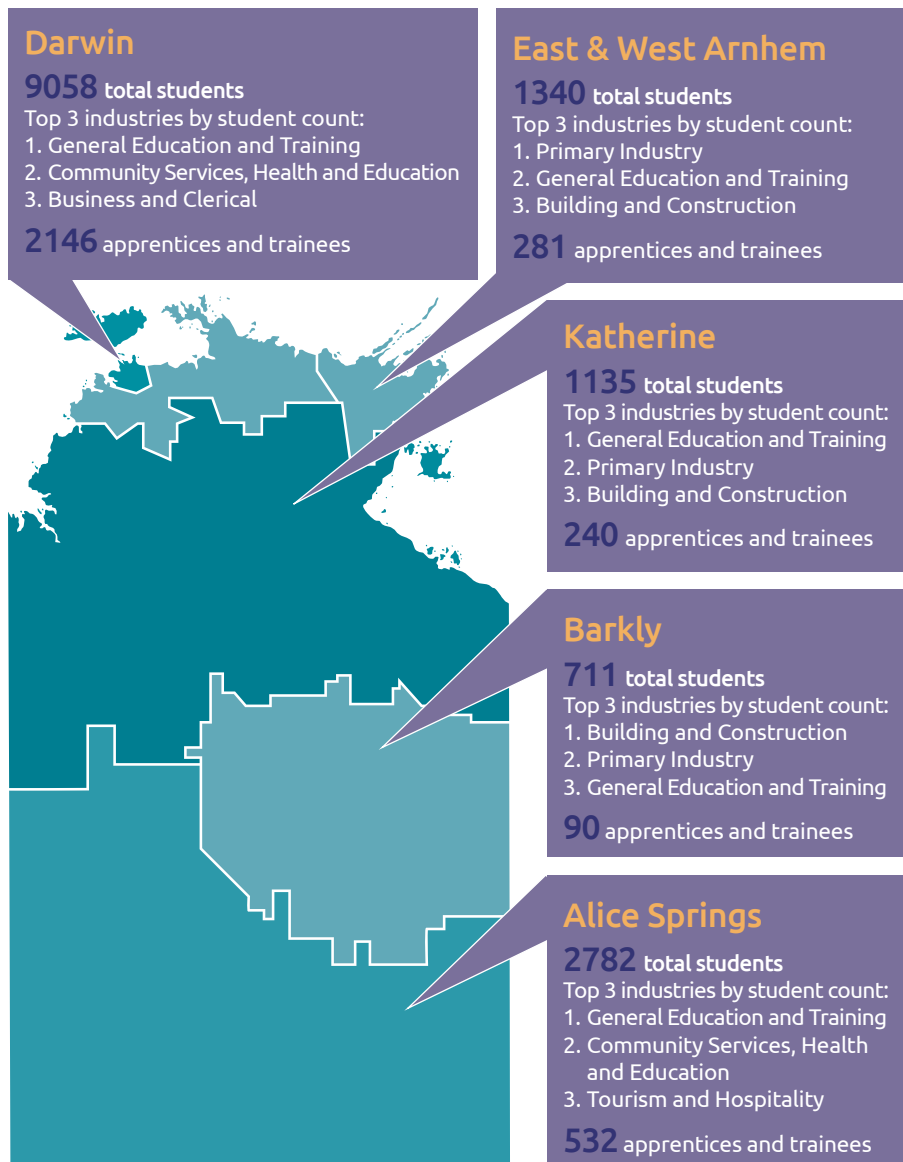
NT Designated Area Migration Agreement

Signed a Deed of Variation in March 2022, providing more occupations now 124, increasing places to 625 annually and increasing concessions such as a higher age limit against some occupations.

NT Global Worker Attraction Campaign

Successfully delivered phase 1 with over 24 million users displaying campaign materials on their screen; just under 1 million online engagements and 3,150 completed job applications through Seek.

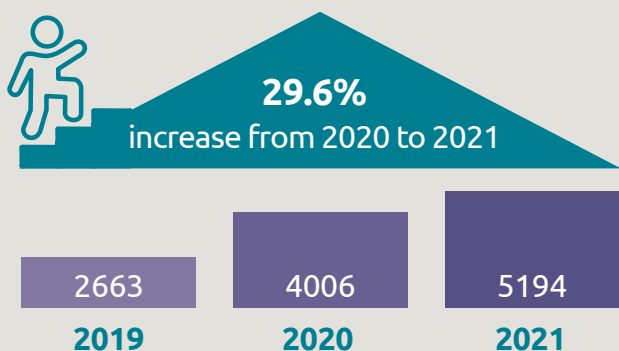
VET student count by region - top industry groups by enrolment

Top 10 apprenticeship and traineeship qualifications - number in training at 31 December 2021

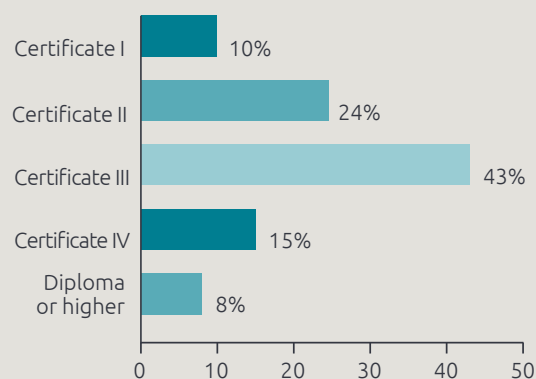


Number of students who improved employment status after training
